Reporting Semifinal Winners & Scores	All scores must be reported on the LHSAA member site immediately following the match.
Program Information & Sideline Pass List	<p>Team roster information must be submitted on the official roster form located under Forms & Downloads on the soccer page of the LHSAA website. Rosters, team photo and school logos must be emailed to Michael Ritch at mritch@lysasoccer.com by Tuesday, February 13. Team photos must be emailed in the form of a .jpg file.</p> <p>A completed sideline pass form must be submitted along with team roster information. This form is located under forms and downloads on the soccer page of the LHSAA website.</p> <p>Please copy fbuckner@lhsaa.org</p>
Home Team	The higher seeded team shall be the home team.
Officials	Four (4) officials per game will be used and are assigned by the LHSAA.
Trainers	Trainers will be provided by the Lake Charles Sports Medicine Institute. All participating schools must provide their own tape, as tape will not be provided by Lake Charles.
Sidelines	<p>All field and team bench personnel must be affiliated with the team in an official capacity. Passes must be worn at all times.</p> <p>Four benches, two tables, one trashcan along with Powerade cooler, cups, Powerade, water and ice will be provided. No utility carts will be allowed on the playing surface at any time.</p> <p>Sideline items shall not be in conflict with Baden and Powerade</p>

	Spectators will not be allowed on the field at any time prior to, during, or after the game. There will be no exceptions to this rule.
Dressing Rooms	Two (2) dressing rooms will be available. It is recommended that all teams arrive dressed for the game. The teams will not return to the locker rooms after the game, so all personal belongings must be removed.
Team Hosts	Team hosts will be provided for each participating team in the championships. The host will contact the schools once finalists are determined. They will answer any questions the schools/coaches will have.
Practice	Teams will not be allowed to practice on the game field.
Band/Cheerleaders	If your school plans on bringing the band and/or cheerleaders, they must be included on sideline pass list. The number of members and their names must be provided.
Team & Individual Pictures	RomaPics will be at the tournament Wednesday through Saturday to take team and individual pictures prior to the start of each match and also for the award presentations following each match. Teams are required to meet the photographer at the designated photo area located between the team locker rooms at the scheduled time listed.
Coaches Hospitality	The coach's hospitality room will be located in the Cajun Field Team Lounge. Admission is for LHSCA Coaching Card and LHSOA Official Cardholders only. Guests will not be permitted to enter the hospitality room.
Game Balls	The Baden Perfection Elite SX751-CPL (Teijin Microfiber PU Cover, FIFA approved) will be used in all championship matches. Game balls will be provided by the LHSAA. Teams must provide their own warm-up balls.

Locker Room Facilities	Restrooms and showers are available in each locker room. No towels or soap will be provided. It is the responsibility of each team to leave the locker rooms in the same condition in which they were occupied. A pregame and postgame inspection of the locker rooms will be performed. Any damage or missing items will be replaced at the expense of the school. Training facilities will be located outside of the team locker rooms in a designated area.
Team Bus Parking	Team buses will park in the main parking lot in the gravel area.
Playing Surface	<p>The Ragin' Cajun Soccer Field is a Hybrid Bermuda grass field. Metal cleats are not allowed on the playing field at any time.</p> <p>No gum, sunflower seeds, tobacco products or other food products will be allowed on the playing field at any time.</p>
Postgame Presentations	Following the completion of the game, award presentations will begin on the field. Teams will shake hands and then return to their bench. Both teams are required to participate in post-game presentations and are asked to return to the locker rooms immediately following.
All-Academic Presentations	<p>All-Academic Presentations will take place during halftime, which is approximately 45 minutes after the start of the match.</p> <p>All-Academic recipients will enter through the LHSAA Pass Gate. Please see site map for location entry. Recipients are allowed free entry for themselves and up to two guests.</p>

SCHOOL YEARBOOK

The principal must complete the online form and request credentials by 4:00 PM on Monday, February 19. The principal must also submit a letter on school stationery authorizing the individual(s) to be credentialed. The purpose of the "School Yearbook/ Newspaper" credential is to permit a complimentary entrance into the event for which the person is gathering information. If the request is granted, one tournament pass will be issued for a yearbook and/or newspaper staff member with proper school identification

Photos taken during an event may not be sold or used in any capacity outside of the purpose(s) of their school's yearbook and/or newspaper. The LHSAA has an exclusive photography contract with RomaPics.

RADIO/INTERNET BROADCASTING

The fee per game is \$200. If a station agrees to do LHSAA sponsor reads, the fee is reduced to \$150.

TEAM FILMING AREAS

There are two media stands located in the bleachers. Teams are allowed to film in one of those two locations or on the media tower located on the opposite side of the field. (See site map) Only one videographer, per school, will be allowed to utilize the media tower or stands. A pass will be required to enter the field. Please request a media credential.

Directions To The Venue:

From Baton Rouge, La.: Lafayette, Louisiana is located 65 miles southwest of Baton Rouge (68 miles from the airport). By automobile the trip will take approximately 1 hour. Below are directions to assist you in your travel. Take I-10 West out of Baton Rouge and travel 55 miles and exit the interstate at exit # 100 (Ambassador Caffery) and turn left. Then follow Ambassador Caffery Parkway and proceed to Bertrand Drive into Lafayette.

From New Orleans, La. (via I-10): Lafayette, Louisiana is located 137 miles west of New Orleans (128 miles from the airport). By automobile the trip will take approximately 2.2 hours. Below are directions to assist you in your travel. Take I-10 West out of Baton Rouge and travel 55 miles and exit the interstate at exit # 100 (Ambassador Caffery) and turn left. Then follow Ambassador Caffery Parkway and proceed to Bertrand Drive into Lafayette.

From New Orleans, La. (via US 90): Lafayette, Louisiana is located 137 miles west of New Orleans. By automobile the trip will take approximately 2.2 hours. Below are directions to assist you in your travel. Take I-10 West out of New Orleans and exit the interstate at exit 220 and merge onto I-310 South and travel 12 miles before exiting onto US Highway 90 West towards Houma. Travel 124 miles and turn left onto University Ave. Travel one mile to downtown Lafayette and the University Campus.

From Lake Charles, La.: Lafayette, Louisiana is located 215 miles east of Houston (225 miles from the airport). By automobile the trip will take approximately 3.3 hours. Below are directions to assist you in your travel. Take I-10 East out of New Orleans and travel 205 - 215 miles and exit the interstate at exit # 100 (Ambassador Caffery) and turn right. Then follow Ambassador Caffery Parkway and proceed to Bertrand Drive into Lafayette.

From Shreveport, La.: Lafayette, Louisiana is located 215 miles southeast of Shreveport. By automobile the trip will take approximately 3 hours. Below are directions to assist you in your travel. Take I-49 South out of Shreveport and travel 207 miles and take exit 1B onto I-10 West towards Lake Charles. Travel approximately 3 miles and exit the interstate at exit # 100 (Ambassador Caffery) and turn left. Then follow Ambassador Caffery Parkway and proceed to Bertrand Drive into Lafayette.
