Reporting First Place District Winners	<p>Friday, November 2, 2018 by 10:00 PM</p> <p><i>(Teams playing Saturday, November 3 must report <b>immediately</b> following the completion of the game, and no later than 8:00 PM.)</i></p> <p>District Winners/Ties must be reported the District Chairperson using the District Reporting Form located on the football page of the website.</p>
Wildcard Program and Power Ratings	Addressed under Sections 14.9 through 14.14 in the 2018-19 LHSAA Handbook.
Power Ratings Online – Disputes	<p>Sunday, November 4, 2018 between midnight and 8:00 AM.</p> <p>Disputes must be emailed to Kathie Smith (<a href="mailto:ksmith@lhsaa.org">ksmith@lhsaa.org</a>).</p>
Release of Final Brackets	<p>Sunday, November 4, 2018 during the LHSAA Pairings Show, which airs at 11:00 AM on Cox Sports Television (CST).</p> <p>Brackets will be posted on the LHSAA website throughout the Pairings Show.</p>
Determining the Home Team	<p><b><u>Bi-District Round of Play</u></b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. In the sports of baseball, basketball, football, soccer, softball and volleyball in all classes/divisions, the higher seeded team shall be the home team.</li> <li>2. A “bye” shall be counted as a home game.</li> </ol> <p><b><u>Regional Round of Play (Non-Select Football)/Quarterfinal Round of Play (Select Football)</u></b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. In the sports of baseball, basketball, football and soccer, in all classes/divisions:             <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Any team that drew a bye in the first round shall be the home team.</li> <li>b. The team that traveled in the first round shall be the home team.</li> <li>c. If both teams traveled or were home teams in the first round, the higher seeded team shall be the home team.</li> </ol> </li> </ol> <p><b><u>Quarterfinal Round of Play</u></b> <i>(If played on a home-away basis)</i></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The team that has traveled more in the first and second rounds shall be the home team.</li> <li>2. If both teams have traveled the same number of times in the first and second rounds, the higher seeded team shall be the home team.</li> </ol> <p><b><u>Semi-final Round of Play</u></b> <i>(If played on a home-away basis)</i> - The higher seeded team shall be the home team.</p> <p><b><u>At the State Championships</u></b> <i>(in all applicable rounds of play)</i> - The higher seeded team shall be the home team.</p> <p>Opposing schools may, by mutual agreement, reverse a game site. A reversal of the home/away site for any reason shall not affect the criteria cited in the above rules.</p>

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Responsibility of Reporting Playoff Winners	<p>The <i>winning</i> team will enter the results of the games on the LHSAA Member Site immediately after the game. Phone calls, emails or faxes are not accepted to report scores.</p> <p>If the winning team fails to report the outcome of a state playoff game to the LHSAA by 11:00 PM on the day of the contest, the school shall be fined \$100.</p> <p>The <i>home</i> team for the next round shall enter all game information online.</p> <p>The higher seed shall be the home team for the finals.</p>
Officials for Playoff Games	Assigned by the Director of Officials, Lee Sanders, for all rounds of the playoffs.
Number of Officials	<p><b><u>First and Second Rounds</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ All Games - Five on field and one clock operator *</li> </ul> <p><b><u>Quarterfinals and Semifinals</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Fifteen Games - Six on the field and one clock operator *</li> <li>▪ Nine Games - Seven on the field and one clock operator *</li> </ul> <p><b><u>Finals</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ All Games - Seven on the field and two clock operators</li> </ul> <p><i>* The home school may request a 25 second clock operator for any round of the playoffs. Contact the assignment secretary.</i></p> <p>The clock operator shall be paid.</p>
Officials Pay	Addressed under Section 8 of the 2018-19 LHSAA Handbook.
25 Second Clock Operators	Must be a responsible adult.
Escort and Security for Officials	Must be provided by the home team. School must provide staff member and at least one law enforcement officer to meet and escort officials to dressing room before, at halftime, after the game and to their vehicle upon leaving the stadium. Arrange for a meeting place for officials at halftime and after the game.
Admission Prices	Must be agreed upon by both schools.
Broadcasts (Internet/Radio/Television)	<p>Must be agreed upon by both schools.</p> <p>Fees become part of gate receipts.</p>
Use of Video Taping to “Scout” Playoff Opponents	Illegal unless <i>both</i> schools agree in writing prior to the game.
Passes	Only LHSAA/LHSCA, Football Officials, and Media Passes will be honored.
Comp Passes	Must be agreed upon by both schools and must be reasonable.
Admission for Support Groups	To be determined by both schools.

Playoff Percentage to LHSAA	<p>Ten percent (10%) of <i>gross</i> receipts before any deductions are made. The financial statement must be sent to the LHSAA with your school check made payable to the LHSAA.</p> <p>Playoff Financial Form will be created once a playoff game score is entered. To get forms, the principal will need to sign in to the LHSAA member site, select "Forms" tab and select "Financial Forms."</p>

(Example: John Deaux)</li> <li>▪ Use the following formats when entering numbered information on the forms: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Height: Enter using only a hyphen between foot and inches. Do not use apostrophes or quotations. (Example: 6-1)</li> <li>○ Weight: only include the number. Do not use "lbs." after the number. (Example: 190)</li> <li>○ Grade: Enter only numbers to represent the grade level. Do not use abbreviations or "th" after the number. (Example: 12)</li> </ul> </li> <li>▪ <u>Send the above-mentioned forms as a word document. PDF documents, handwritten forms, and/or faxed documents will not be accepted.</u> If forms are not properly submitted, the school will be asked to resubmit by the deadline.</li> </ul> <p><b><u>Team Photos and Logos</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Both photos and logos must be sent as a high resolution color files.</li> <li>▪ Images should be at least 300 dpi.</li> <li>▪ Acceptable file types are .jpeg, .png, .tif or .eps.</li> <li>▪ Team photos should be at least 9 inches wide.</li> </ul> <p>All documents must be sent to Kathie Smith (<a href="mailto:ksmith@lhsaa.org">ksmith@lhsaa.org</a>)</p>
