

#### 7th Annual "Beyond the Game" Sportsmanship Essay Contest Application Presented by the Louisiana High School Athletic Association

**BACKGROUND:** The LHSAA "Beyond the Game" Program is hosting its Seventh Annual Sportsmanship Essay Contest. This is an opportunity for students, attending our member schools, to get creative and tell us what it means to go "Beyond the Game" in sportsmanship.

First place will be awarded a prize of \$500, a framed copy of the winning essay, and recognition by the LHSAA at the Beyond the Game Awards Banquet – LHSAA Office in Baton Rouge, time TBD.

<u>GUIDELINES</u>: The essay contest is open to all students in grades 9-12 (ages 14-18), who attend an LHSAA member school. Entries must be typed using 12 point, Times New Roman font, and double-spaced, with a maximum length of 500 words.

#### STUDENT SHOULD INCLUDE

- ✓ Student Application Forms including the additional information of:
  - Signed verification of cumulative GPA by the student-athlete's counselor or on-site school records clerk (Transcript)
- ✓ Student essay

<u>STUDENT ESSAY</u> - The provided topic for the essay is: "How Has Participation In Competitive Play Contributed To Your Commitment To Sportsmanship As A High School Athlete?" The applicant should include references to: trustworthiness, respect, responsibility, fairness and/or caring. <u>The maximum length is 500 words</u>. This essay should accompany the application, but be on a separate page.

Essays exceeding the 500 word maximum and/or do not address the topic will be disqualified. Essays not following formatting guidelines (12 pt, Times New Roman font, double spaced) will be disqualified.

<u>IUDGING</u> - The judging of applications and selection of winners will be conducted by a committee organized by the LHSA office staff. Winners will be notified late-MAY 2019.
